ASCM certificate - Warehousing

Objectives

For the learner :

- > Have an overview of distribution inventory management, product storage, packaging and shipment, sustainability in logistics.

For the Company :

- > Have the skills of its teams recognised with an international certificate
- > Have staff with an internationally recognised level of warehousing expertise
- > Have leaders who can contribute to the company's transformation plans

At the end of the training program, the learner will be able to:

- Take part in the loading and shipping processes, and work with common shipping documents.
- Schedule shipments and use various methods to track the shipments.
- Follow an effective order fulfillment cycle and work to improve order accuracy and efficiency.
- Use inventory management systems in warehouses and distribution centers to accurately report the quantity and value of the materials received, stored and shipped to customers.
- Categorize inventory and manage the costs associated with holding inventory.
- Manage customer returns.
- Follow environmentally sustainable work practices on the job.
- Make appropriate decisions about the use of different types of transportation carriers, understanding their characteristics and the advantages and disadvantages of each.
- Apply different performance metrics to measure the success of a facility in the warehousing and distribution industry.

Public and Prerequisite

Logistics process professions: procurement, planning, purchasing, logistics, stock management, workshop management. A 1st experience or training (initial or professional) in Supply Chain, as well as basic knowledge in flow management are recommended.

Program

8 modules:

1. Introduction to Warehousing and Distribution
2. Jobs in warehousing
3. Safe material handling and equipment operations
4. Principles of quality, sustainability, and continuous improvement

6. Distribution inventory management and control
7. The role of transportation in the supply chain
8. Technology

Duration, pedagogical sequencing and tools

The course lasts 10.5 hours, divided into 3 half-days of virtual classes. It is necessary to be able to set aside time for personal work (30 hours in total).

The training sessions are built around practical applications that require prior reading of the chapters on the ASCM platform: discussions on key points, questions/answers, exercises, case studies, professional illustrations, group work.

To support personal work, we provide:

- Access to the ASCM e-learning platform: online materials, videos, quizzes.

- Access to AGILEA's Next platform: additional resources and workspace for running virtual classes and sharing between learners.
- Training exercises, illustrations, questions, group work, etc.

Results monitoring and assessing

ASCM Warehousing Certificate exam : 60 questions, 2 hours, open-book exam.

Methods for evaluating training by learners

- At the end of the training course, a training assessment questionnaire is handed out, aimed at evaluating :
- o the overall level of satisfaction
 - o the achievement of the defined objectives
 - o possible areas for improvement in terms of both content and form
