ASCM certificate - Planning

Objectives

For the learner :

- > Understand the fundamentals of supply chain planning
- > Understand the synchronized planning approach, where stakeholders work together to create cohesive and integrated plans that support the organisation's objectives.

For the Company :

- > Have the skills of its teams recognised with an international certificate
- > Have staff with an internationally recognised level of planning expertise
- > Have leaders who can contribute to the company's transformation plans

At the end of the training program, the learner will be able to:

- Understand the flow of planning from business plan to execution
- Link business strategy to company plans
- Contribute to production and control activities
- Interpret and manage the master production schedule
- Interpret and manage the material requirements plan
- Determine order and reorder points
- Create a channel tree design for a distribution system
- Identify technologies to support synchronous planning

Public and Prerequisite

Logistics process professions: procurement, planning, purchasing, logistics, stock management, workshop management. A 1st experience or training (initial or professional) in Supply Chain, as well as basic knowledge in flow management are recommended.

Program

6 modules :

- What is synchronized planning ?
- Strategic planning - Business planning
- Strategic planning – Demand planning and SOP
- Tactical planning – MPS/MRP/Capacity management
- Operations execution - Purchasing and PAC, APS
- Distribution and logistics planning

Duration, pedagogical sequencing and tools

The course lasts 10.5 hours, divided into 3 half-days of virtual classes. It is essential to set aside time for personal work (30 hours in total).

The training sessions are built around practical applications that require prior reading of the chapters on the ASCM platform: discussions on key points, questions/answers, exercises, case studies, professional illustrations, group work.

To support personal work, we provide:

- Access to the ASCM e-learning platform: online materials, videos, quizzes.
- Access to AGILEA's Next platform: additional resources and workspace for running virtual classes and sharing between learners.
- Training exercises, illustrations, questions, group work, etc.

Results monitoring and assessing

ASCM Planning Certificate exam : 78 questions, 3 hours, open-book exam.

Methods for evaluating training by learners

At the end of the training course, a training assessment questionnaire is handed out, aimed at evaluating :

- o the achievement of the defined objectives
- o possible areas for improvement in terms of both content and form
